OVERVIEW OF A TELEDERM APPOINTMENT

How does Otn.teledermSF® work?

An Otn.teledermSF® appointment is just like a regular appointment, only in addition to an examination, your doctor will take digital photographs of your skin condition and will forward them electronically to a dermatologist.

The dermatologist will review the information, make a diagnosis and send treatment recommendations back to your doctor. Your doctor will follow up with you about the suggested treatment plan.

Occasionally the dermatologist may request that your doctor take additional pictures or perform a procedure to complete the diagnosis of your skin condition.

However, in the vast majority of cases, you will not have to travel to see the dermatologist for a face-to-face appointment.

This service is provided by OTN.

Are my images private?

Yes! Your images are always private and secure. The images of your skin condition reside on a secure data server hosted by OTN. All images and personal health information are transmitted through an encrypted connection and physician access to the data is password protected & in accordance with the 'Personal Health Information Protection Act 2004'. Step 1: Health Care Provider

Your health care provider takes a digital photograph of the affected area.



Step 2: Document & Digital Image The information is bundled with patient health data and "stored" on a secure server.



Step 3: Specialist

The information is "forwarded" to the dermatologist who reviews your data and images and makes a diagnosis and treatment recommendation. This information is sent back to your health care provider.
