POSITION SUMMARY:

Community based ophthalmologist position providing comprehensive ophthalmic care at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (OSMH) with possible affiliation with other regional hospitals. OSMH is moving forward with the New Graduate Initiative proposed by the Provincial Vision Task Force, for ophthalmologists who have graduated in the last five years. The position requires a permanent location of office and surgical practice full time to the Orillia catchment area. There is opportunity to share office space and resources to get established.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

On-Call:

Provision of regional on-call services covering LHIN 12 (currently 1 in 7)

In-Patient:

Consultation for OSMH credentialed staff and regional partners

Peri-operative management of own patients

Participation and cooperation as a contributing team member

Retinopathy of prematurity examinations of neonates at OSMH

Out-Patient:

Provision of care for all patient types including surgical, paediatric, medical, and chronic care patients, sharing these different types of patients in an equitable and community-oriented manner with other members of the division.

COMPENSATION:

Fee for Service; HOCC for on-call

QUALIFICATIONS:

This position is open to an ophthalmic surgeon who has an Ontario license and has been certified by the Royal College within the last five years. Applicant must be eligible for appointment to the credentialed staff at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital.
