The ER sees 54,000 patients per year and is well supported by local and regional specialists.

REMUNERATION: Through an Alternate Funding Agreement for emergency room physicians and Hospital On-Call Coverage (HOCC) for the ER Backup shift.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must hold an unrestricted license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of this position. A fellowship in Family Medicine or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada specializing in Emergency Medicine would be an asset. Applicant must be eligible for appointment to the Credentialed Staff at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital.
