POSITION SUMMARY: Full-time clinical position responsible for the provision of clinical geriatric consultation services. This position will provide leadership and consultation for Senior Friendly Initiatives within the hospital, collaboration with the North Simcoe Muskoka Specialized Geriatric Services to develop a Regional Integrated Geriatric System and participation in the Couchiching Ontario Health Team (currently in development).

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: Geriatric Consultation: Provision of in-patient geriatric consultations for hospitalized patients and patients admitted to the Acute Care of the Elderly Service in collaboration with other medical staff and assigned geriatric hospital staff; and participation in the development of strategic and operational plans for an in-patient unit with a focus on seniors' care (Acute Care of the Elderly Unit). <u>Seniors' Care Clinic:</u> This is an established out-patient clinic with multi-disciplinary team affiliated with the Couchiching Family Health Team and other local partners. Responsibilities include participation in the development of strategic and operational plans to link the outpatient clinic with in-patient hospital activities and provision of specialized medical expertise and consultation to patients within an interdisciplinary team model.

ON-CALL: The position will provide the opportunity to share in Internal Medicine on-call responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must be a licensed physician in the Province of Ontario and Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in Internal Medicine. Applicant must be eligible for appointment to the Credentialed Staff at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital.
