The successful candidate(s) will be joining a group of 10 anesthesiologists and provide anaesthesia services at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (OSMH).

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES: In addition to providing general anesthetics for services including general surgery, ENT, gynecology, plastic surgery, orthopedics, urology and ophthalmology, the successful candidate will possess experience in managing pediatric and obstetrical cases. Other responsibilities will include pre-admission clinic consultations, administering sedation in the endoscopy suite and providing support for difficult cases in the emergency department. Opportunity for ultrasound guided regional anesthesia and for participation in anaesthesia procedure clinic for chronic pain management exists for candidates with adequate training.

ON-CALL: Provision of average 1 in 10 call.

COMPENSATION: Fee for service and HOCC for on-call.

QUALIFICATIONS: College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) unrestricted license that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of this position.
