Position Summary

Two part-time GPO's will work collaboratively to provide services in the satellite Oncology Clinic at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (OSMH) with leadership from the Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Program (SMRCP). The satellite center at OSMH provides chemotherapy and outpatient cancer care to residents living in the region of Simcoe Muskoka.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The GPO will provide services as per Cancer Care Ontario guidelines and in a team setting with nurses and other allied healthcare workers. Oncologist support will be readily available at the SMRCP. The GPO will provide outpatient care and inpatient care as a consultant to the Most Responsible Physician for oncology patients at OSMH. This role is responsible for providing full assessment of patients, and supervision of appropriate diagnostic and systemic treatment plan, in Systemic Treatment, the treatment plan is reviewed with the Oncologist. The GPO will provide assessment of follow-up patients, and initiation of appropriate tests and investigations when indicated as per CCO guidelines. The GPO will be considered part of the larger team at SMRCP, with opportunities for Continuing Professional Development and collaboration. The GPO will work collaboratively with the clinical and administrative team to provide leadership congruent with the Vision, Mission, Values and strategic objectives of OSMH, Cancer Care Ontario, and the SMRCP.

REMUNERATION: Fee for Service

QUALIFICATIONS: Independent license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of the position. Will have or seek appropriate training opportunities such as CAPGO scholarship placement at the SMRCP within the first year of the position. Achieved or working toward Focused Practice Designation with the College of Family Physicians of Canada within the first year of the position
