Position Summary

General orthopaedic surgeon with experience in trauma care and hip/knee arthroplasty. Additional fellowship training is strongly preferred.

This is a community-based position providing a high quality efficient service with access to scheduled and emergency operating room and ambulatory care clinic resources at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (OSMH) while maintaining a full-time office practice in the city of Orillia. Equal participation in provision of in-hospital and regional outreach and on-call services, as well as comprehensive office based consultations in Orthopaedic Surgery.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: Provision of general orthopaedic consultations for OSMH credentialed staff and regional partners, Collaborative participation with other OSMH orthopaedic surgeons to provide uninterrupted, consistent and responsive on call coverage, Daily round on inpatients, Coverage of the fracture clinic, and Participation in WSIB Ontario Workers Network (OWN) referrals and procedures, compliance with OWN policies and processes. **ON-CALL:** Collaborative participation for on-call coverage will be shared 1 in 5.

COMPENSATION: Fee for Service, HOCC for on-call, and WSIB OWN fees as per schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS: College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) unrestricted license that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of this position and fellowship in orthopaedic surgery recognized by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) is required. Fellowship training in a subspecialty area would be an asset.
