

AV Fistulogram, AV Fistula-angioplasty, AV fistula-side branch embo, or AV fistula-thrombolysis Patient Preparation

Procedure time will vary from 1.5 - 2.5 hours (approximately). The patient will briefly recover from the procedure in Diagnostic Imaging while the remainder of their recovery will be in the Dialysis Unit while using their AV Fistula for the next 3 - 4 hours (unless otherwise arranged). Plan to be at the hospital all day.

## **Patient Preparations:**

You may have a light meal **up to four hours** before your procedure. Continue to take your prescribed morning medications, **EXCEPT FOR** blood thinners, with a small sip of water. This procedure *may* require the use of **conscious sedation**. You will need to arrange for someone to drive you home after you have recovered from the procedure and/or dialysis session (if going to dialysis). Please bring a list of drug/medication allergies.

## Bloodwork:

The following bloodwork must be <u>arranged by the Referring Physician</u> and is required within **1 week before** the procedure: **INR, PTT, CBC, CREATININE** 

Bloodwork results are to be faxed to the Diagnostic Imaging department at 705-330-3224

Please note:Patients on Warfarin (Coumadin) require new INR drawn the day before the procedure.Please note:Unavailable bloodwork results may cause a delay or rebooking of the procedure.

## Anticoagulation / Antiplatelet Medications:

If you take any of the following medications then they must be stopped prior to the procedure as per the listed times. Discuss this with your physician if you have concerns about stopping any medications:

Medication	Number of Days to Hold
Enoxaparin <i>(Lovenox)</i>	Withhold 1 dose before procedure
Dalteparin <i>(Fragmin)</i>	Withhold 1 dose before procedure
Apixaban <i>(Eliquis)</i>	Withhold 3 days before procedure
Rivaroxaban <i>(Xarelto)</i>	Withhold 3 days before procedure

Medication	Number of Days to Hold
Dabigatran (Pradaxa)	Withhold 4 days before procedure
Warfarin <i>(Coumadin)</i>	Withhold 5 days before procedure until target INR ≤ 1.8
Clopidogrel (Plavix)	Withhold 5 days before procedure
ASA (Aspirin)	Withhold 5 days before procedure

Please call the DI Nurse at 705-325-2201, ext. 3497 if you have concerns about holding your patient's anticoagulation / antiplatelet medications.
