

Diagnostic Imaging – Interventional Radiology

Procedure time is 15 - 30 minutes. There is no recovery period after, and you will immediately go over to MRI for your scan after the injection.

## Patient Preparations:

You should wear loose-fitting clothing that is easy to change out of. Please bring a list of drug/medication allergies.

## Bloodwork:

Bloodwork is generally not required for joint injections. If you are at a high bleeding risk due to your medications then discuss with your doctor if it is safe to withhold your medications prior to the procedure.

Bloodwork results are to be faxed to the Diagnostic Imaging department at 705-330-3224

Please note: Patients on Warfarin (Coumadin) require new INR drawn the day before the procedure. Please note: Patients will be screened for MRI safety prior to arthrogram joint injection.

## Anticoagulation / Antiplatelet Medications:

If you take any of the following medications then talk to your doctor if you need to stop them. If your doctor recommends stopping your medications then follow as listed below:

Medication	Number of Days to Hold	Medication	Number of Days to Hold
Enoxaparin (Lovenox)	Withhold 1 dose before procedure	Dabigatran (Pradaxa)	Withhold 4 days before procedure
Dalteparin <i>(Fragmin)</i>	Withhold 1 dose before procedure	Warfarin <i>(Coumadin)</i>	Withhold 5 days before procedure until target INR ≤ 1.8
Apixaban <i>(Eliquis)</i>	Withhold 3 days before procedure	Clopidogrel (Plavix)	Withhold 5 days before procedure
Rivaroxaban <i>(Xarelto)</i>	Withhold 3 days before procedure	ASA (Aspirin)	Withhold 5 days before procedure
