Procedure time is approximately 30 minutes. Internalization of an existing nephrostomy tube into a nephroureterostomy tube may take up to 1 hour. There is no recovery time post procedure. These tubes must be changed every 3 months.

## Patient Preparations:

The patient should wear loose-fitting clothing that is easy to change out of. Please bring a list of drug/medication allergies.

## Bloodwork:

No bloodwork is required for routine existing tube exchanges.

## Anticoagulation / Antiplatelet Medications:

Medications do not need to be stopped for routine tube exchanges. If unsure about specific medications then please call the DI Nurse to discuss.
