OSMH is a schedule 1 psychiatric facility with 25 in-patient beds in addition to a robust out-patient psychiatry program, a day hospital program and crisis services. The mental health program is staffed with about 90 interdisciplinary employees including RNs, RPNs, Addictions Counsellors, Social workers, and OTs.

We are a unique program in that our in-patient unit is staffed with a psychiatric hospitalist. This physician in on-site daily, working alongside the mental health team and is responsible for managing all in-patient medical issues. In comparison to other psychiatry placements, OSMH psychiatrists are remunerated well by these sessional/stipend fees.

We are a growing community that now has an established University Campus. Situated between Lake Couchiching and Lake Simcoe we are just 1 hour outside of the Greater Toronto Area. The community is well known for its hiking trails, the numerous lakes and rivers, skiing, mountain biking as well as a vibrant and ever-developing downtown with numerous restaurants and services.
