OSMH is a level 2c obstetrical center with a level 2c nursery located in the Simcoe-Muskoka region of Ontario. We offer high-risk obstetrical care, and are a regional referral center for at least 5 level 1 hospitals (Huntsville, Bracebridge, Midland, Collingwood and Parry Sound). Opportunity for group practice exists with office space, EMR and administrative assistance.

We are interested in expanding the group to allow for teaching opportunities, regular educational rounds, supervision of residents and to keep up with the growing community!

The OB/GYNE program is well-supported by a robust pediatrics program and an adult 10-bed closed ICU. We have a full complement of specialist services including Anesthesia, Urology, General Surgery, Pathology, Laboratory Services, Ophthalmology, ENT, Orthopedics, Intervention Radiology and Plastic Surgery. Additionally, we have local access to Gynecological Oncology and Emergency Interventional Radiology in Barrie (30 minutes away).

We are a growing community that now has an established University Campus. Situated between Lake Couchiching and Lake Simcoe we are just 1 hour outside of the Greater Toronto Area. The community is well known for its hiking trails, the numerous lakes and rivers, skiing, mountain biking as well as a vibrant and ever-developing downtown with numerous restaurants and services.

Qualifications

- College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) unrestricted license that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of this position.
- Fellowship in Obstetrics and Gynaecology recognized by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC).
- Special interest or sub-specialty training in advanced laparoscopy, urogynecology and/or community infertility (cycle monitoring, OI, COH and IUI) is considered an asset.

We are open to providing short term supervision for a full time candidate who is in the process of Royal College licensing.

Our birthing numbers are currently 1,000-1,100 deliveries/yr with expected population growth within the region.

The OB specialist provides both high risk OB care and primary care OB. In addition, they provide support to our local family physicians practicing obstetrics and an active midwifery group.

In-hospital services will include OR access and colposcopy clinic. Opportunities for OR access at our regional partners also exist in both Bracebridge (MAHC) and Midland (GBGH).
